I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Ebenezer lot no.1 with all the buildings and improvements there unto belonging and the north end of lot no. 15 until it joins the part of the same lot that I give to James MacLeod and also one-half of

I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Henry if he beliving forty pounds.

I give and bequeath to my well beloved son William one-half of lot no. 14 the west side only reserving the improvement on the south side of the road on highway so long as my wife lives for her use and also one third part of the mowing ground

I give and bequeath to my well beloved daughter Mary Compton twenty shillings to be given to her twelve months after my decease.

I give and bequeath to my well beloved daughter Elizabet hone-half of lot no. 12 the west side, one cow and one feather bed bedding and bedstead.

I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Daniel lot no. 2 and that part of lot no. 3 that is not given to my son David with the improvements on said lots and the south end of lot no.15 from the highway and the one-half of the above named lot

I give and bequeath to my well beloved nephew James MacLeod ten acres of land and of lots no.

15 beginning on the north side of the highway until it comes within two rods of the western most line of lot no. 16 from thence south until it comes to

I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Liddy Vaughanall the remainder of my estate real and personal with all debts, dues, bonds, notes of hand and also the use and benefit of lot no. 1 with the buildings and improvements that is given
